

## Barbara Reimers Jaeger

September 5, 1938 - January 3, 2021

Funeral services for Barbara Jaeger, 82 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Friday, January 8, 2021 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings, Texas with Rev. John Waak officiating. Entombment will follow in the Giddings City Mausoleum. Visitation will be held on Thursday, January 7, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, January 8, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Due to the current Covid 19 Pandemic, everyone attending the visitation and funeral services are asked to wear masks and practice social distancing.

Barbara Reimers Jaeger was born on September 5, 1938, in Paige, Texas, the daughter of Wilhelm Reinhardt Reimers and Leora Louise (Kiel) Reimers. She was baptized in Paige, Texas and confirmed in Hempstead, Texas. Barbara graduated from Giddings High School in 1956 and began working at Nutrena Feeds in Giddings. She was united in marriage with Alois Jaeger on September 1, 1963 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. Shortly after, she began working alongside her husband as secretary at Jaeger's Inc. in Giddings. Barbara was an active member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings where she sang in the choir, taught Sunday school, was a member of the women's organization, and served on the Altar Guild. She was a member and served as an officer of the Lee County Heritage Society. She enjoyed working in her yard, traveling, walking trips, cooking, and baking. Her greatest joy was spending time with her family. Her grandkids fondly remember her Wednesday night suppers and her Sunday lunches after church. A much-requested meal consisted of chicken strips with sweet rice.

Barbara passed away the morning of Sunday, January 3, 2021 at Oakland Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, W.R. and Leora Reimers; sister, Jeanette Lindley and her husband Henry; brother, Kenneth Reimers; two brothers-in-law, Kenneth Hannes and Elwood Jaeger and his wife Gladys.
