July 23, 1919 - January 11, 2015

Funeral services for Aileen Blume, 95 of Ledbetter, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m on Saturday, January 17, 2015 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will be in the Ledbetter Cemetery. Aileen Neutzler Blume was born on July 23, 1919 in Greenvine, Texas to Adolph "Tom" Neutzler and Alma (Wickel) Neutzler. She was baptized on November 30, 1919 at Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Greenvine by Rev. J. Leo Hoefer and confirmed on April 9, 1933 also at Emmanuel Lutheran Church by Rev. Carl Ziehe. Her confirmation verse was Matthew 6:33, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you". Aileen was united in marriage to Kermit Blume on July 18, 1940 by Rev. Carl Ziehe at Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Greenvine. She and Kermit owned and operated the Ledbetter Store for several years. Aileen also worked in the office at the auction barn in Giddings for many years. She and Kermit were always active members of the Ledbetter community. Aileen was one of the original members of the Ledbetter Homemakers Club and volunteered countless hours helping with the annual Ledbetter Homecoming and Ledbetter Volunteer Fire Department's Firemen's Feast. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings and

enjoyed sewing and traveling. She passed away during the early morning hours of Sunday, January 11, 2015 at St. Mark's Medical Center in La Grange.

Aileen was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; her brother and sister-in-law, Branch & Nelita Neutzler and her sister, Janet Lehmann.
