

Albert Norbert Matthijetz

January 31, 1941 - October 19, 2024

Funeral services for Albert Matthijetz, 83 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 24, 2024 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, October 23, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, October 24, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Wednesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Albert was born on January 31, 1941 in Giddings, Texas to Norbert and Freida (Duisberg) Matthijetz. He was baptized on February 16, 1941 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. G.W. Fischer and later confirmed on April 3, 1955 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Port Arthur by Pastor Orville A. Buntrock. Albert's confirmation verse was Matthew 10:32 "So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven". After graduating from Thomas Jefferson High School in Port Arthur, Texas, he joined the Marine Corps where he served for a year and a half before transferring to the Air Force where he served for three years and eight months before being honorably discharged from the service. Albert met his wife during his service days, and they married on June 8, 1963 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Max Studtmann officiating. To this union they were blessed with two children, Sharon and Douglas. Albert worked many different jobs including truck driving, being in partnership with

his cousin in the brick laying business and also working at City Meat Market before settling into working as an independent landman for many years until retirement. He was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church where he had served as an usher. Albert also was a member of the Giddings Volunteer Fire Department for several years. He enjoyed watching sports, playing dominoes, golfing, hunting, and traveling. He had the opportunity to experience seeing many places through the years including Germany and Alaska. Albert never met a stranger and was always ready to help others. His family was his main focus and he especially enjoyed the opportunity of taking care of his great granddaughter.

Albert passed away the evening of Saturday, October 19, 2024 at Care Inn in La Grange.

He was preceded in death by parents, Norbert & Freida Matthijetz; three sisters who died in infancy; in-laws, Herbert & Irene Moerbe, and sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Dorothy "Jane" and Joe Orts.

Albert is survived by his wife of 61 years, Judy Matthijetz of Giddings; two children, Sharon & Ricky Proske of Giddings and Douglas & Inez Matthijetz of Corpus Christi; four grandchildren, Sara & Bruce Prellop of Giddings, Christopher Proske of Giddings, Marisa & Brooks Kasper of Giddings, and Isaac Matthijetz of Corpus Christi; one great granddaughter, Hattie Mae Prellop of Giddings; sister and brother-in-law, Ruth & Richard Sessions of Orange; brother and sister-in-law, David & Judy Matthijetz of Giddings as well as several nieces and nephews.

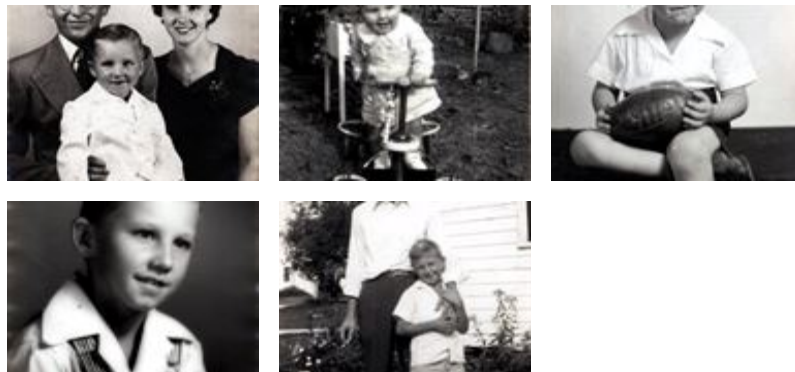
