Albert, Jr. was home schooled by Sylvia Cass of the Rockdale I.S.D. from 1975 to 1979, due to being born with Cerebral Palsy and special needs. Although Junior could not walk or talk, he has his special way of communicating, at times in hilarious ways, such as; throwing his cup at the wall when he desired a second serving of strawberry malt or sweet tea.

Albert, Jr. was cared for, at home by his mother until she became ill and eventually passed away. His mother loved him unconditionally and took excellent care of him. Two months prior to his mother's death, Albert, Jr. along with his mother moved to Hewitt, Texas to live with his sister, Willow Bell Moultrie-Robertson and his brother-in-law, Donovan Robertson where he remained until his death. Albert, Jr., received the best of care from his sister Willow (guardian and caregiver) brother-in-law, Donovan (caregiver) and

niece, Pebbles Wesley (caregiver) for the last 10 years of his life.

Junior, also known as Juna Bug, Duna, and JuJu, will be greatly missed by all his family and those who knew him. The love and compassion shown to Junior, by all was unconditional.

He was preceded in death by his mother and father; Two sisters, Carol Lynn and Joyce Elaine Moultrie; one great nephew, Deontae Deshaze Kinney.
