Albert Weller, also known as Hootie, was born January 14, 1937 in Galina Park, Texas to August Henry and Emma (Gotthard) Weller. He served in the U.S. Army for August 30, 1955 to August 15, 1958. On August 26, 1960, he and Marilyn L. Wolfe were married in Richmond and Rosenberg. They came to Rockdale where he worked as a welder with Alcoa and currently worked in the garden center at Walmart in Rockdale. He is a member of Mt. Zion Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon.
