



Albert Regan Worley

June 4, 1965 - June 28, 2022

Funeral services for Albert Regan Worley, 57 of Lincoln, will be held on Friday, July 1, 2022 at 10:00 am at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Pastor Ross Worley officiating. Burial will follow in the Taylor City Cemetery, with a reception at the American Legion Hall in Lexington following graveside services. Regan was born on June 4, 1965 in Tyler, Texas to Arvil Ross Bill Worley, Jr and Mary Lou (Kelm) Worley. He loved sports and played football, baseball, and basketball for the Thrall Tigers, where he graduated high school in 1983. He also loved a good round of golf. After high school, he went on to work as the manager of Golden Fried Chicken in Taylor, then a Sales Representative for Schwan's for many years. He moved to the Lexington/Giddings area and worked for the Giddings State School in various capacities. He found his home at LF Manufacturing in Giddings, where he worked as a Plant Manager for almost 20 years.

Regan loved to cook, but his favorite past-time was BBQ. He enjoyed competing in the Lexington and Giddings cook-offs with one of his long-time friends. Together, they won many trophies, his most proud being his 2019 Reserve Champion belt buckle from the Giddings API beef cook-off.

Regan loved his family fiercely. He married his best friend, Monica Delaney, on June 9, 2018. Together, from their previous marriages, they have 7 children and 7 grandchildren. His grandbabies were the apple of his eye and would do absolutely anything they asked. He had an endless supply of popsicles in the freezer, living room pony rides, and wheelie-popping lawnmower cruises around the yard.

Regan passed away peacefully in his home surrounded by family on the morning of Tuesday, June 28, 2022.

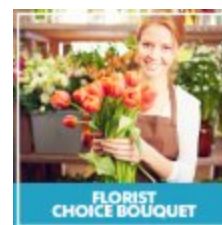

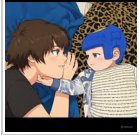
