February 26, 1921 - September 17, 2011

Alex Hosek was born February 26, 1921 in Cameron to Joseph Andrew and Anna Klapka Hosek. Alex served in the U.S. Army as a fire control operator during World War II. He served from December 23, 1942 to December 27, 1945, serving in Bismarck, Archipelago, New Guinea, Southern Philippines and Luzon. He received the Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with 4 bronze stars and a bronze arrowhead; Philippine Conduct Medal; 4 Overseas Service Bars; 1 Service Stripe and Victory Ribbon. On May 14, 1946, he and Geraldine Dreher were married in Cameron. They lived in Rockdale the past 32 years and previously lived in Corpus Christi where he was a machinist for Pittsburg Plate Glass Company. Alex passed away Saturday, September 17, 2011 in the Scott & White Hospital in Temple, reaching the age of 90. He was preceded in death by his wife 64 years, Geraldine on September 20, 2010.
