Alfred Gilbert Beisert was born on February 24, 1938, in Loebau, Texas, the son of Louis G. & Minnie (Hohle) Beisert. He passed away Saturday, May 18, 2024 at the age of 86.

Funeral services are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 23, 2024, at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau with Rev. David Mumm officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Christ Lutheran Church Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, May 23, 2024, from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Wednesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Alfred was baptized on March 7, 1938, and confirmed on May 18, 1952. His confirmation verse was 1 Timothy 4:8, "For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come". He was baptized, confirmed and married at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau. He was a Godly man – a true and faithful Christian. If the doors were open at church, you could always find him there.

At the young age of 17, Alfred met the love of his life, Betty. On May 31, they would have celebrated 66 years of marriage. He was the most loving and perfect husband. He took care of Betty in every way.

In the early years, Alfred and his brother, Robert, started Spring Branch Drywall in Houston. Years later, he started his own business, Alfred Beisert Drywall. He continued this business until moving back to the "country" in 1983. He operated Circle B Feed for several years, worked for Lincoln Fertilizer, and raised cattle all during these years. He loved his cows, and in fact, Betty thought he might have loved them more than her. Alfred was a true believer in hard work. He raised his three girls with the same belief.

Many years were spent playing the guitar in a country music band with his brothers. They played in several dancehalls including the Esquire Ballroom in Houston. Some of his earliest memories would include trail rides with the family, seining tanks with the Schimanks, watching community baseball on Sunday afternoons, enjoying a cold one, and playing a few games of dominoes at Deal's Place and Walch Store. He was a huge fan of the Houston Astros and the Texas Aggies! Every weekday at 12:30, you could find him watching the Bold and the Beautiful. Once the kids and grandkids were old enough for sports, that's where you would find him. He traveled near and far to watch a ballgame, and you can bet he was every kids #1 fan.

Alfred was a quiet man, a man of few words, but you never doubted his love for you. He loved his family more than anything, especially those grandkids. They could do no wrong in his eyes. He was so proud of each one of them. He was a good friend to many, and his list was long, ranging from young to old. He had a witty sense of humor, which lasted right until the end. He could turn a bad day into the best day with that sweet little smile.
