Alice Lorine Mitschke was born on January 28, 1942 in Northrup, Texas. She was called to her Savior's side and eternal home on Sunday, January 19, 2020 at her home in Northrup, Texas.

Alice was the daughter of Isidor & Elsie Noack Mitschke. She was born again into the Kingdom of God through Holy Baptism on February 1, 1942 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Pastor Hermann Schmidt officiating. She confirmed her faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as her Savior and Lord at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin on March 25, 1956 with Pastor A. Arndt officiating. She then worked for two different oil companies from February 1981 until June of 1986. Alice then worked for Bluebonnet Electric Cooperative from September of 1986 until August of 2006. She then began working for Leeco Industrial Plastics for the next five years and retired in August of 2011. Alice enjoyed working in her flowerbeds and trading plants with friends. She looked forward to shopping and having lunch with friends. Her passion was serving people as she helped serve food at funerals, volunteered at the Giddings Area Food Pantry for several years, and helped with the to-go line at Wendish Fest. Most of all she looked forward to the time spent with her family and friends.

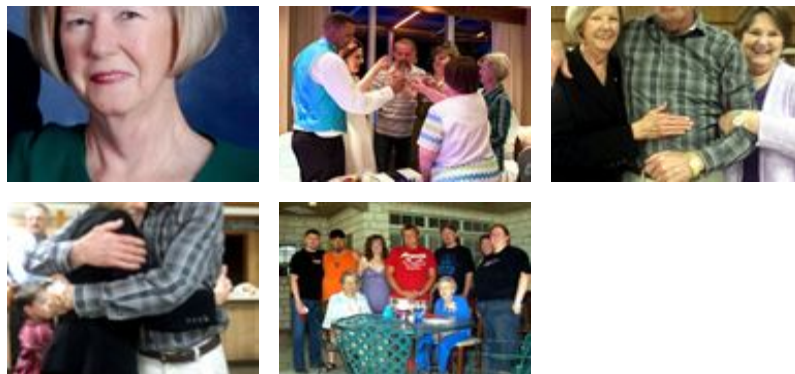

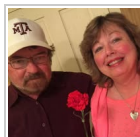
