Allyne Mullins was born October 30, 1920 in McCulloch County, Texas and grew up near Thorndale. She was the oldest of 11 children born to Henry Nathan and Delila (Catchings) Edwards. She has lived in Austin since 1944. On October 8, 1937, she and Johnie E. Mullins, Sr., were married in Brady. Allyne worked as a caregiver with a children's day care. She touched hundreds of lives through her caring love of children, affectionately known as MeMe by many who were in her care and those who placed their children in her care. Allyne was a bright spot in the nursing home where she spent her last years. Allyne passed away Monday, September 10th, in the Brackenridge Hospital in Austin, reaching the age of 91. She was preceded in death by her husband on August 16, 1995, her parents, two brothers Alton and Virgil Edwards and a sister Audrey Taylor.
