Almond Lee Moultrie, Jr., age 71 of Austin, formerly of Rockdale, passed away Monday morning, October 7, 2019 at his daughter's home in Pflugerville. Services for Mr. Moultrie are scheduled for 12:00 p.m. with the viewing at 11:00 a.m. Saturday, October 19, 2019 at New Hope Baptist Church in Rockdale with Pastor Kenneth Morris officiating and Rev.
