



Alois "Al" James Jaeger

February 23, 1932 - August 31, 2025

Funeral services for Alois Jaeger, 93, of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, September 8, 2025, at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings, Texas, with Rev. John Waak officiating. Entombment will follow in the Giddings City Mausoleum. Visitation will be held on Sunday, September 7, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, September 8, 2025 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Sunday afternoon from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Alois James Jaeger was born on February 23, 1932, in Carmine, Texas, to Edwin and Frieda (Marx) Jaeger. He was baptized on July 10, 1932, and confirmed on April 14, 1946, at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Carmine. Al attended Texas A&M University, where he was a member of the Corps of Cadets, and graduated in 1954 with a Bachelor of Business Administration. He served in the United States Army and was stationed at Fort Totten in Queens, New York. After his discharge, he returned to Giddings to work in his father's business, Jaeger's, Inc.

On September 1, 1963, Al married Barbara Reimers, and they were blessed with two children, Jim and Kim. Al and his brother, Elwood, continued to run Jaeger's, Inc. in Giddings and Shiner, which remained under Jaeger family ownership and management for 80 years. He truly loved his work and often

said, “If you love what you do, you’ll never work a day in your life.” He cherished his many customers, who became dear friends.

A devoted member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings, Al served on the church council and was active in his community in various capacities. He enjoyed traveling, a good meal, and visiting with family and friends. His greatest joy was spending time at the farm, where he loved working the land. His grandchildren will always remember his many stories and history lessons. He instilled in his children and grandchildren a love of God, family, and a strong work ethic.

Al passed away peacefully on the afternoon of Sunday, August 31, 2025, at his farm in Lincoln.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 57 years, Barbara Jaeger; parents, Edwin and Frieda Jaeger; his brother, Elwood Jaeger; and his wife, Gladys; sister-in-law, Jeanette Lindley, and her husband, Henry; and brothers-in-law, Kenneth Hannes and Kenneth Reimers.

He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Jim and Deanna Jaeger of Giddings; his daughter and son-in-law, Kim and Tim Walther of Giddings; his grandchildren—Jacob and Maycee Jaeger; Jansen and Savannah Jaeger of Giddings; Kaylen Jaeger of Austin; Hudson Walther, Brooklyn Walther, Jaxson Jaeger and Jarett Jaeger all of College Station—and three great-grandchildren, Sutton, Jack, and Taitum Jaeger of Giddings; his brother, Murray Jaeger (with Terri Lyons) of Serbin; and his sister, Mickey Hannes of Houston, and several nieces and nephews.

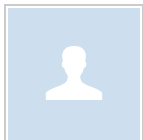

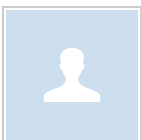
