



Alton "Al" Eugene Wiederhold

February 27, 1946 - May 14, 2020

Funeral services for Alton "Al" Wiederhold, 74, of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 18, 2020 at St. Margaret's Catholic Church in Giddings with Father Miguel Duarte officiating. Visitation will be held on Sunday, May 17, 2020 from 11:00 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. and on Monday, May 18, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. A private family Rosary will be recited Sunday evening after visitation.

Alton Eugene Wiederhold was born on February 27, 1946 in Austin, Texas to Arnold & Martha (Schultz) Wiederhold. He was united in marriage to Angelina "Angie" Gonzales on November 10, 1973 at St. Margaret's Catholic Church in Giddings, Texas. He was a route salesman for Mrs. Baird's Bread.
