Amanda Otilie "Tillie" Albrecht, loving wife, mother and grandma passed away peacefully on Thursday, November 26, 2009 at her Paige home. She was 88 years old. Services were held at Martin Luther Lutheran Church, in Giddings, on Saturday, November 28, 2009 beginning at 1:00pm and a graveside services followed at the Friendship Cemetery in Hills, TX. Tillie was born at home in Fayette County, Texas on June 17, 1921 to Carl and Clara Mitschke Synatschk. She was baptized by Rev. A.
