Funeral services for Amanda Milburn, 93 of Cedar Park, Texas will be held on Saturday, May 16, 2020 at 2:00 pm with Rev. Kevin Westergren officiating. A private family burial will take place at a later date.

Amanda Renata Milburn was born on May 14, 1926 in Giddings, Texas to Robert August and Martha Rosine (Fischer) Biebas. She was baptized on May 23, 1926 by Rev. C.W. Rische and confirmed on March 17, 1940 by Rev. E.J. Riske at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, Texas. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 143:10, "Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness". She married Richard William Milburn Jr. on July 25, 1948 at Ebenezer Lutheran Church. They had two children, Mark and Tammy. Amanda was the cafeteria manager at Redeemer Lutheran School in Austin for many years, until reaching the age of 82 when she needed to "slow down a little". Her hobbies were cooking and spending time with her son and daughter-in-law. She enjoyed their time together as well as visiting different restaurants. She would also enjoy the fall and return of the UT Longhorn football season while sharing those times and camaraderie with both her son and daughter-in-law.

Amanda passed away the afternoon of Friday, May 8, 2020 in Austin, Texas.

Richard Milburn Jr.; brother, Albert Biebas; and sister, Louise Mutscher.
