Andrew Albert Richter was born on May 12, 1951 in Houston, Texas to Henry August Richter and Edna Louise (Dube) Richter. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Houston. After attending college, Andrew worked as an administrative assistant at Exxon and also as Deputy County Clerk for Harris County. On June 5, 1982, Andrew married Rebecca "Becky" Price at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Houston. Andrew was an avid history buff and could have been called an amateur historian. He had a wealth of knowledge about Texas history, especially the Alamo, World War II, and circus history. Besides his large collection of history books, he also collected memorabilia from the golden age of film and tv. Andrew enjoyed traveling to California and would seek out historical markers and museums wherever he went. Besides his happy-go-lucky personality, he had the voice of a radio announcer and remembered everything.

Andrew passed away the evening of Sunday, February 12, 2023 at Oakland

Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry and Edna Richter.

Andrew is survived by his wife, Becky Richter of Cincinnati, OH; one aunt, Margaret Richter of Fedor; sisters and brothers-in-law, Mary Mire, Nancy Stankorb, James Price, and Jerry Price cousins he considered sisters, Sharon & Curtis Schimank of Lincoln and Karen & Kenneth Patschke of Lexington, and several other cousins.

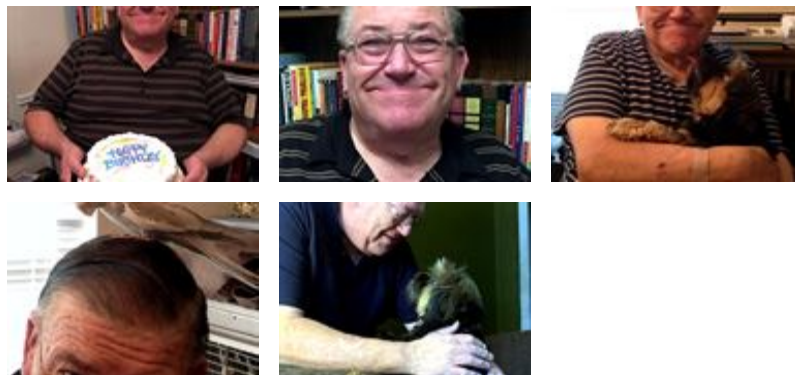
