He loved to read and even as a child he would hide under his bed with a flashlight so he could continue to read after his bedtime. He also collected baseball caps.

Aniceto passed away unexpectedly the afternoon of Saturday, October 19,

2019 near Pecos, Texas.

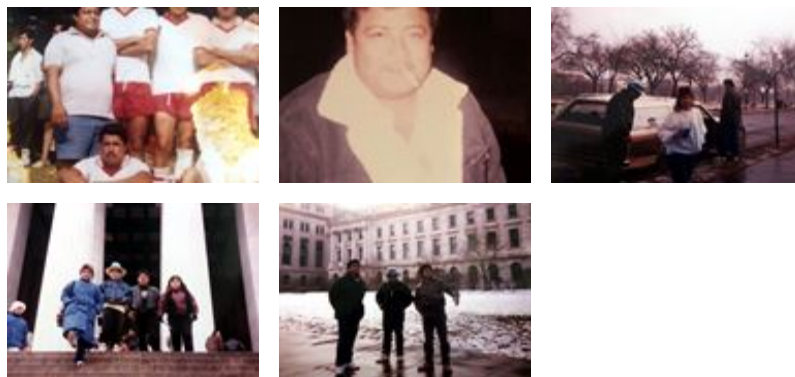

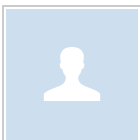
