



Ann Marek Chernosky

April 27, 1930 - January 18, 2019

Funeral services for Ann Chernosky, 88, of Old Dime Box, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m., on Monday, January 21, 2019 at the Dime Box Brethren Church in Dime Box, Texas with Pastor Jim Heckman officiating. Burial will follow in the Hranice Cemetery in Dime Box. Annie Mae (Voight) Chernosky was born on April 27, 1930 in the Paint Creek Community of Bastrop County, Texas. She was the daughter of Frank August Voight and Frieda Alvina (Domann) Voight. She was baptized and confirmed at St. John Lutheran Church in Lexington. Ann attended school in String Prairie before her family moved to Chrisman and she attended school at Porters Chapel and eventually Caldwell High School.

She married Joe Marek on November 23, 1946 in Dime Box. Together they owned and operated Marek's Café in Dime Box for many years. After closing the café, Ann worked at Weaver's Café in Lexington, R & K Café in Lexington, Lexington High School, Dodd Grocery in Dime Box, Henessey Nursing Home in Giddings, the Bon Ton Restaurant in Giddings, and retired from the Giddings State School in 1992. Following Joe's death in January of 1989, Ann married one of her childhood sweethearts, Emil Jenke Sr. in 1992. They

enjoyed life together and traveled before his sudden death in April of 1994. In June of 1995, she married Clarence Chernosky. Together they owned and operated Downtown Café in Dime Box from 1995 until 2005.

She was a longtime member of the Dime Box Brethren Church, the Sons of Hermann, the SPJST Lodge #13 in Dime Box where she had served as the assistant youth leader and an insurance agent, the Lexington Lions Club and the Lexington Garden Club. Ann loved to travel, sew, bake, play dominoes and decorated her home for every holiday and season. She will be remembered for her positive attitude and outlook on life no matter what struggles and trials she was enduring. She never complained and always looked toward the brighter days that would lie ahead.

Ann passed away the afternoon of Friday, January 18, 2019 at the CHI St. Joseph Regional Health Center in Bryan following a brief illness.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Frank & Frieda Voight; her husbands, Joe Marek and Emil Jenke Sr.; her son-in-law, Neil Ahrendt; her grandson, Ryan Ahrendt; one sister, Gladys Ngiratumrang, and three brothers, Franklin Voight & his wife, Margaret, Alton "Bunny" Voight, and Eldie Voight & his wife, Edna.

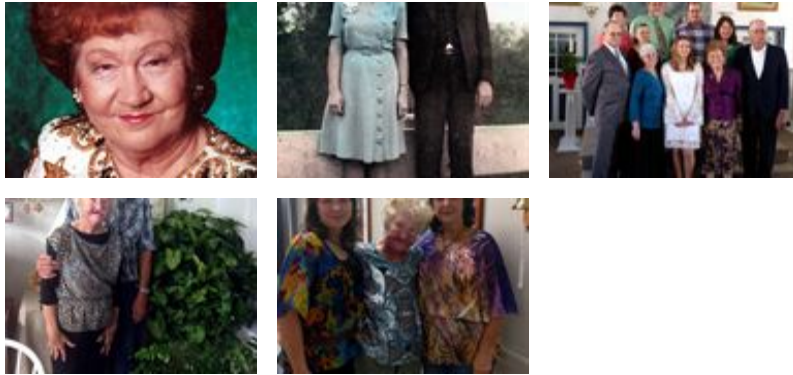

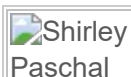
