



Anne Marie Chadwick

June 5, 1927 - August 23, 2019

Memorial services for Anne Marie Teague Chadwick, 92, of Giddings are scheduled for 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, August 31, 2019 at First United Methodist Church in Giddings with Pastors Patricia Wehn-Glowski and Wes Morgan officiating.

Anne Marie was born in New York City on June 5, 1927, the daughter of Merwyn C. Teague and Sarah Irby Teague. She lived on Long Island New York until she was 10 years old, when her family moved to Ridgewood, New Jersey. She was a good student and graduated from Middlebury College, Vermont with a B.A. in Psychology and Child Development.

Anne Marie met her future husband at Middlebury and married Robert Green Chadwick on April 15, 1950 in the Community Church, Jackson Heights, New York. She was active in church work by teaching Sunday school and working for the women's organizations. Anne Marie also sang in church choirs from junior high until she was in her late 80's. She loved to sing and had a strong alto voice. She and her husband Bob sang in church choirs for over fifty years. Before her marriage to Bob, Anne Marie taught nursery school and took up this career again when their youngest child reached 6th grade. She enjoyed vegetable gardening, sewing, cooking, trying new recipes, family history, and building landscaping and structures for their model train layout. She loved being a mother, grandmother, and great grandmother.

In the course of their 62 years of marriage, Bob and Anne Marie lived in Pennsylvania, Vermont, Kentucky, Ohio, and in the Texas cities of Seabrook, Dayton, Conroe, and Giddings. They enjoyed being close to their five children, nine grandchildren and six great grandchildren. During the 20 years they lived in Dayton, they enjoyed country living, having lots of dogs, cats, horses, and cattle.

Anne Marie and Bob were devoted and active Christians, supporting their church, in whatever way they could. Their last move was to Giddings in 2008 where they joined the First United Methodist Church.

Anne passed away the morning of Friday, August 23, 2019 in Giddings, Texas.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; daughter, Judith Evans dePara; sister and brother-in-law, Jane Irby Teague Barton and Reverend Charles A. Barton; sister-in-law, Joan Haskins Corker, and brother-in-law, Daniel A. Nelson.
