



Annie Mae Ahlhorn

Funeral services for Annie Mae Ahlhorn, 91, of Paige, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Annie Mae Bieberstein was born May 9, 1927 in Giddings, Texas to Ben and Alma (Herzog) Bieberstein and died May 24, 2018. Annie Mae attended school in Giddings where she completed the eighth grade. She was employed as a clerk at Elkins Store where she enjoyed working with many wonderful people.

On May 9, 1948 she married Delbert Elmo Ahlhorn at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings, Texas by Delbert's brother-in-law, Reverend Carl Mutschink. Annie Mae and Delbert celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary and both of their birthdays in May 2018. They lived in west Texas and the Rio Grande Valley where Delbert worked in the oilfield. During this time they started their family with the births of Larry, Donny, Debbie and Brenda.

Annie Mae was a talented seamstress and made her children's clothes. She taught Sunday school at Zion Lutheran Church in Alamo, Texas. Annie Mae loved spending time with family, especially the children, and being a devoted aunt. Upon her retirement, Annie Mae enjoyed being outside in her garden and bird watching. She loved taking care of animals and her beloved dogs. Annie Mae was always ready with open hands to serve any need or any person.

In 1969 they relocated to Paige, Texas where they owned and operated Ahlhorn's Grocery for over twenty years. They enjoyed providing a place where friends came together every day for groceries, entertainment and information. They made numerous lifelong friends and made many contributions to the community.

Annie Mae is survived by her husband of 70 years, Delbert E. 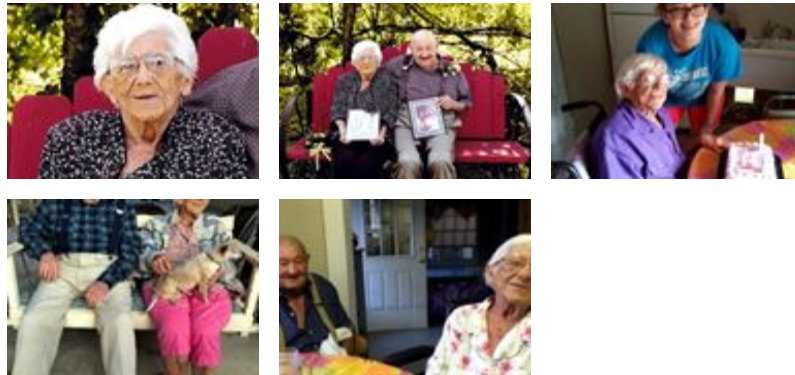
