



Sister Annie Ruth Scurlock

June 18, 1939 - June 26, 2023

Memorial services for Sister Annie R. Scurlock, 84 of Dime Box, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 8, 2023 at Church of Jesus Christ of Dime Box Texas in Dime Box, Texas with Brother Dewayne Blue officiating. Burial was held in the Giddings City Cemetery on Tuesday, June 27, 2023.

Pastor/Sister Annie Ruth Oliphant Scurlock was born on June 18, 1939 in Tillatoba, Mississippi, the daughter of Emmanuel and Arle (Anderson) Scurlock. After High School, she went on to earn a college degrees in nursing and criminal justice. Sister Annie worked in the D.A. Office in Tennessee. She was highly involved with numerous police associations, the NAACP. She gave her life to the Lord on March 26, 1972. In the early years of her ministry she participated in Missionary work in North and Central America. He sponsored numerous children in India and the United States with St. Jude. Sister Annie pastored a church in Madisonville, Texas and Memphis, Tennessee before her final destination in Dime Box, Texas. Sister Annie went on to develop and lead her congregation in Dime Box at The Church of Jesus Christ of Dime Box, Texas. While in the ministry, she was very active in the New Testament Christian Academy, ministered at numerous prisons and was very active in the community. Sister Annie loved gardening and always had a large garden and flowerbeds. She was dedicated in reading her Bible, fasting, and praying. She lived a life of Holiness and Dedication to Jesus Christ and loved teaching the young women of the church to be the chase keeper of the home and godly

women. Most of all sister Annie loved preaching the Word of God. She believed in family and enjoyed spending time with her family.

Sister Annie went to be with the Lord on Monday, June 26, 2023 at her home in Dime Box with her family and church members by her side.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Emmanuel and Arle Scurlock; granddaughter Shakana Howard and five brothers.

Sister Annie is survived by her five children, Diane Boyland, Barbara Ray, Carloyn Boyland, Jacquelin Neal and (Kirk) all of Dime Box, and Frank Meza and (Legia) of Austin; ten grandchildren; twelve great grandchildren; one great great grandchild; four siblings, Sallie Scurlock of Illinois, Bessie Steward, Nancy Walker (Doug) all of Tennessee, and Shirley Scurlock of Michigan as well as numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and church family.
