



Arthur Clarence Jatzlau

He attended Trinity Lutheran School in Fedor. Arthur was united in marriage to Paula Laura Eschberger on October 12, 1944 at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim by Rev. Paul Brust. They just celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary. He was a lifelong farmer and rancher. Arthur passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at St. Joseph Regional Health Center in Bryan.
