



Arthur Roy Noack

January 27, 1945 - April 15, 2026

Funeral services for Arthur Noack, 81 of Northrup, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 18, 2026, at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, April 17, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, April 18, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Friday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Arthur Roy Noack was born on January 27, 1945, in Winchester, Texas, the son of Edward Johann Erich Noack and Selma Frieda (Reinhardt) Noack. He was baptized into the Lutheran faith on February 4, 1945, at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt and renewed his baptismal vow through the right of Confirmation on March 22, 1959, also at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. His confirmation verse was Matthew 7:7-8, "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened". Arthur attended St. Paul Lutheran School in Serbin before attending La Grange High School, where he graduated in 1963. He attended Southwest Texas State College and graduated in 1967 with a Bachelor of Science Degree. On June 5, 1971, he was united in marriage to Dianna Oltmann at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Graf. They were blessed with three children,

James, Sandi, and Johnathan.

Arthur began his lifelong career in education in 1967 at Brackenridge High School in San Antonio. After he and Dianna moved back to the Giddings area in 1975, he taught at Giddings High School where he retired after 45 years. Even after retiring, Arthur continued to substitute teach for several years. A lifetime member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, he served as Finance Committee co-chairman, Secretary of the congregation, and on the Board of Education and Board of Elders several times. Arthur was also a charter member of the South Lee County Volunteer Fire Department of which he was a firefighter for 10 years and served as treasurer for over 5 years. Based on his years of service to his church, his community, his family, and his students, Arthur was awarded the Giddings Area Chamber of Commerce's Lifetime Achievement Award in 2012.

Arthur passed away during the early morning hours of Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at St. David's South Austin Medical Center with his family at his side.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Johnnie and Frieda Noack; his brother, Walter Noack, and his parents-in-law, Ernest and Edna Oltmann.

Arthur is survived by his wife, Dianna Noack of Northrup; his three children, James Noack of Dime Box, Sandi Coufal & her husband, Dwain of Temple and Johnathan Noack & his wife, Amy of Bastrop; five grandchildren, Tristan Noack of Dime Box, Luke Coufal & Zara Broda of Temple, Andrew Coufal of Temple, Emma Noack of Bastrop and Ava Noack of Bastrop; one brother, Wilbert Noack & his wife, Carol Jean of Northrup; one sister-in-law, Penny Noack of Pearland; four brothers-in-law, Bobby Oltmann & his wife, Carolyn of Northrup, Dennis Oltmann & his wife, Shirley of Giddings, Ronnie Oltmann & his wife, Linda of Serbin, and Ralph Oltmann & his wife, Darlene of Waco, as well as several nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

Serving as pallbearers will be Edward Noack, Alan Noack, Steven Noack, Keith Oltmann, Craig Oltmann, Gary Oltmann, Jesse Oltmann, and Derrick Oltmann. Honorary pallbearers will be Arthur's grandchildren, Tristan Noack, Luke Coufal, Andrew Coufal, Emma Noack and Ava Noack.

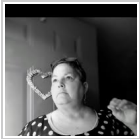

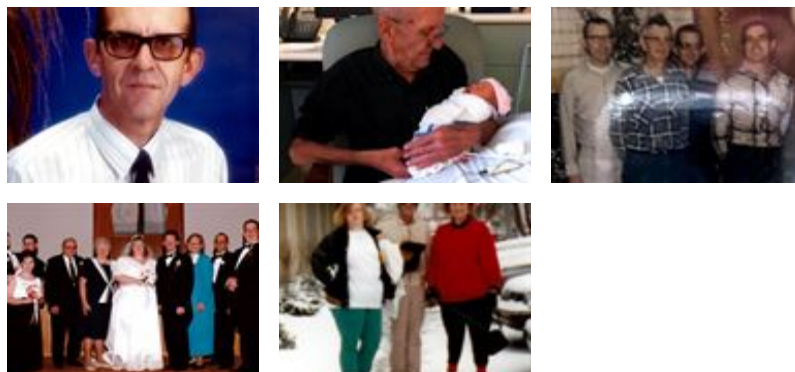
