She loved horseback riding and participating in rodeos and was active in the Burleson County Saddle Club drill team. Gail loved to garden and grew many gorgeous flowers and always had an abundant garden. She truly had a green thumb, and it was said she could make a stick grow. She loved cooking

and hosting big family dinners, especially at Thanksgiving and Christmas. She loved to fish and spend quality time with her family around the tanks at her home. In her younger days, she loved to dance. She also enjoyed singing in the Providence Baptist Church choir. She started taking piano lessons at age 70 which inspired her granddaughter, Caylee, to take piano lessons too. She loved getting together with friends and family to play a game of 42 dominoes. At just 7 days old, she was enrolled in the First Baptist Church Caldwell cradle roll and was a long-time member. At the time of her passing, she attended and was a member of Providence Baptist Church.
