Funeral services for Artis Poston, 79, of Lexington, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial will follow in the St. James Lutheran Cemetery in Lexington. Artis passed away surrounded by numerous family members the evening of Sunday, February 18, 2018 at Copperas Hollow Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Caldwell.

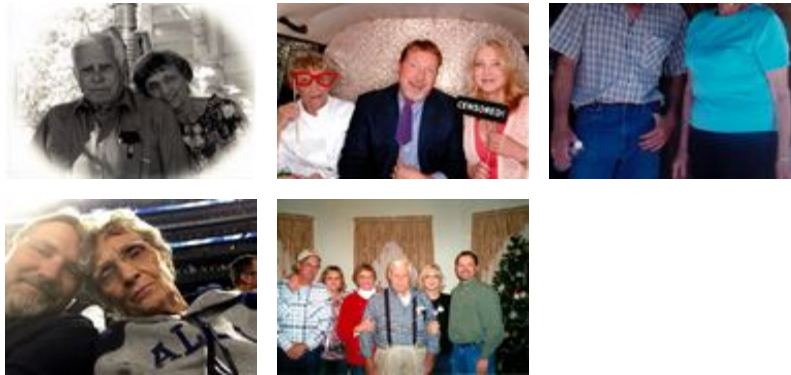
