Asberry Mitchell was born into this world on April 28, 1929 in Bryan, Texas. He was the loving son of Ennis and James Anna (Sheppard) Mitchell. He accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior in 1963 and was baptized into the Church of Christ. Asberry was united in holy matrimony to Vera Mae Johnson on December 18, 1948 in Bryan, Texas. To this union, thirteen children were born. Asberry and Vera Mae were blessed with 65 years of marriage when she preceded him in death on January 18, 2014. Asberry served as the minister of the Lyons Church of Christ for many years and was a faithful member of the Pecan Street Church of Christ in Rockdale. He retired from the Texas Department of Agriculture where he had worked at the seed lab in Giddings. Asberry enjoyed riding his motorcycle, working on his cars and doing lawn service. He spent many hours pursuing religious studies as a

minister of Christ and counseling others through difficult times. His greatest blessing was his family and enjoyed every minute he was able to spend with them.

God called Asberry back to Himself on Sunday, July 14, 2019. After a long and blessed life of over 90 years, he passed away peacefully in his sleep at his home in Giddings.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Vera Mae Mitchell; two sons, Ennis Mitchell and Carl Mitchell; two daughters, Josephine Mitchell and Golly Moore; three sisters and one brother.

Asberry leaves behind to mourn his passing his six sons, Asberry Mitchell Jr. and wife, Beverly of Giddings, Robert Mitchell of Austin, John Mitchell and wife, Lillie Mae of Hutto, Alfred Lee Mitchell of Plano, Virgil Mitchell of Austin, and LeMarion Mitchell of Plano; and his three daughters, Juana Faye Moore and husband, Douglas of Giddings, Shirley Jean Franklin and husband, Eugene of Giddings and Demetrius Richardson and husband, Lawrence of Florida; and twenty-six grandchildren; numerous great grandchildren and great, great grandchildren, as well as a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and many friends.
