She passed away the evening of Wednesday, June 26, 2018 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Louis & Alvina Jeske; her husband, Carl "Charlie" Schramm; her step-daughter, Frances Schulz and her two sisters, Lydia Jeske and Alvina Lehmann.
