Babe Ruth Davis, age 89 of Rockdale, passed away Monday night, August 20, 2018 in St. David's Hospital in Round Rock, Texas.

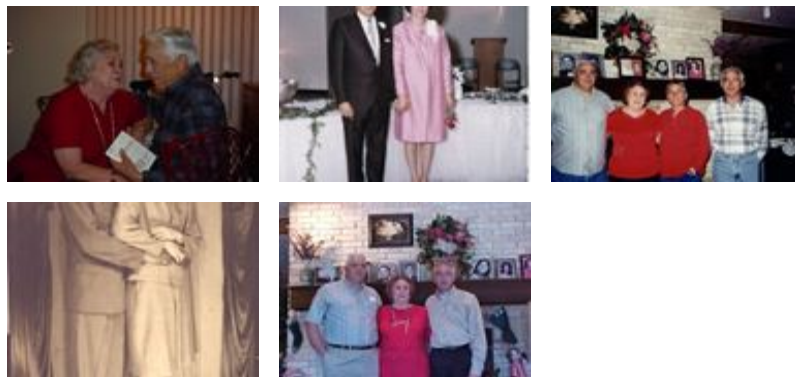
