Barbara Ann Beshears Hormuth, 87, passed away peacefully on June 17, 2026, in Round Rock, Texas. A Rosary and visitation will be held Friday, July 24, 2026, beginning at 5:00 p.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale.
