



Barbara Ann Wolf

April 23, 1945 - January 22, 2023

Funeral services for Barbara Wolf, 77 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on Friday, January 27, 2023 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. John Waak officiating. Burial will follow in Giddings Memorial Park. Barbara Ann (Stuart) Wolf was born on April 23, 1945 in San Angelo, Texas to Tommie and Mary Helen (Roden) Stuart. She loved horses and was a barrel racer becoming rodeo queen of the Wichita Falls Rodeo Association in the early 1960's. Barbara graduated from Wichita Falls High School in 1963. It was while working at the State of Texas Department of Motor Vehicles that she met Fred "Jim" Wolf. According to Jim, it was love at first sight. They were married on July 16, 1966 in Houston, Texas. While living in Houston, Barbara worked at Southwestern Bell in public relations. She and Jim moved to Giddings in 1973 where she was employed with the Lee County Tax Office before eventually going to work as a legal secretary for Schneider, Krugler, and Kleinschmidt where she retired after 32 years. Barbara was an active member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings where she often attended Bible studies. She was an amazing cook who enjoyed gardening and listening to country and western music. Barbara was an excellent seamstress

and painter, especially landscapes. Barbara will be remembered as a good hearted, kind and gentle person, who loved her family and was a loving wife, devoted mother, and proud grandma.

Barbara passed away the evening of Sunday, January 22, 2023 in Smithville, Texas.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Tommie and Mary Helen Stuart; her brother, Ted Stuart, and her parents-in-law, Alfred and Florence Wolf.
