March 12, 1954 - July 16, 2014

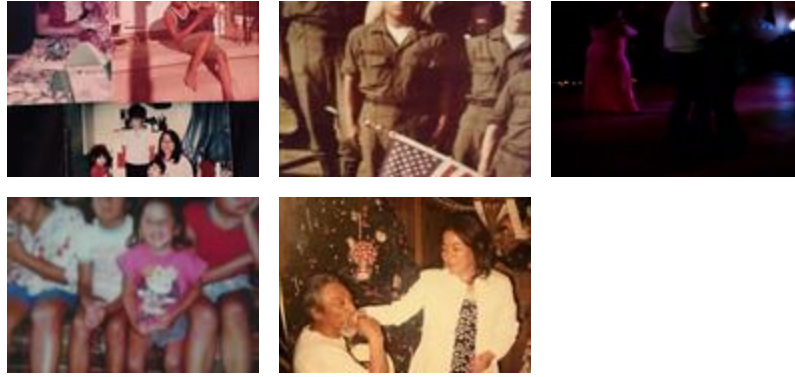
