Being strong willed and particular, Bert always did things his way. On December 14, 2018, he was united in marriage to Carolyn Tuttle, a lifelong friend. They enjoyed singing karaoke together and followed the Lee County Three Band, where the last song of the night was always dedicated to them. Together they would ride around the neighborhood on the 4-wheeler checking the fields and

making sure the neighbors were ok. He will be remembered as a hard worker and was always willing to lend a helping hand.

Bert passed away the morning of Monday, August 8, 2022 at St. David's Hospital in Austin after an extended stay.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Floyd and Imogene Snider and his grandparents, Peter and Elonora Meuth.
