Through the years she worked at Dairy Queen, Melcher's Meat Market, Melcher's Processing Plant and Bill's Dollar Store. She eventually began working at Pieratt's Pharmacy where she continued for 33 years. Betty Jean was a hard worker and always maintained a strong work ethic. She was strong willed and never gave up and served as an inspiration to many others. She never met a stranger and could

always be found visiting and helping others. Betty Jean enjoyed dancing, taking care of her flowers, checking her cattle at the farm, playing cards and dominoes, making noodles, canning and baking. Her family looked forward to her rice krispy treats, banana bread, canned peaches, barbecue sauce, & especially her homemade noodles. She enjoyed time spent with family & friends. Her grandkids, Bodie & Krista were her pride & joy, and she especially loved spending time with them.

Betty Jean passed away peacefully in her sleep the afternoon of Thursday, December 22, 2016 at the Giddings Residence and Rehabilitation Center following a 9 year battle with cancer.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Henry & Leonia Mueller; her husband, Edwin Farrack and her parents-in-law, Oswald & Alma Farrack.
