



Beverly Ann Jackson

July 14, 1953 - May 24, 2026

A service to celebrate the homegoing of Beverly Jackson, 72, of Dime Box, Texas, will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 1, 2026, at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Avis Harris and Rev. Allen Edward officiating the service. She will be laid to rest following the service at Sandy Point Cemetery in Dime Box. Visitation will be held on Sunday, May 31, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, June 1, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Beverly's family will be present to receive visitors Sunday evening from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

On July 14, 1953, Don H. Jackson Sr. and Inez (Benson) Jackson welcomed a baby daughter, Beverly Ann Jackson who was born in Taylor, Texas. Beverly grew up and attended school in Dime Box until her family moved to Temple when she was twelve. She attended Dunbar High School in Temple and graduated from Temple High School in 1971. She worked as an administrative assistant for several years. Beverly yearned to return home and moved back to Dime Box in 1987. She was able to demonstrate her love and compassion for others through her employment with Bluebonnet Trails Community Services and as a private caregiver. At Bluebonnet Trails, she worked in their group homes where she provided loving patient care and skills training to the residents in her care. Beverly had a special relationship with Jessie Walton, with whom she provided care for over 16 years.

Beverly's faith in her Lord and Savior was always an important part of her life. She was baptized at an early age at Sandy Point AME Church in Dime Box and had been a member of the congregations of Wayman Chapel AME Church in Temple, and Rising Star Baptist Church in Dime Box. She shared her faith to others through her musical talents, serving as a speaker at her church and women's conferences and through the love and encouragement she provided to so many throughout her life. Beverly was an exceptional artist, seamstress and crafter. She also supported and volunteered with the Lee County Relay for Life and the Special Olympics for many years.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, May 24, 2026, the good Lord saw fit to call his servant Beverly back home to himself in heaven from Caldwell, Texas. We are sure He greeted Beverly with the words from the Book of Matthew, "Well done, good and faithful servant...enter into the joy of your master."

Awaiting Beverly in her heavenly home were her loving parents, Don H. Jackson Sr. and Inez W. (Benson) Jackson; her beloved son, Reginald J. Jackson; her brother, Don H. Jackson Jr. and her sister, Sandra J. Jackson.

Those left her to cherish Beverly's memory include her three sisters, Patsy Jackson Crawford of Austin, Vernessa Jackson Matthews of Temple, and Nellie Jackson Hickman and her husband, Thomas of Crockett; her loving companion in life, Doug McGrue of Dime Box; her brother-in-law, Arnold Matthews of Dime Box as well as numerous cousins, extended family and many friends.

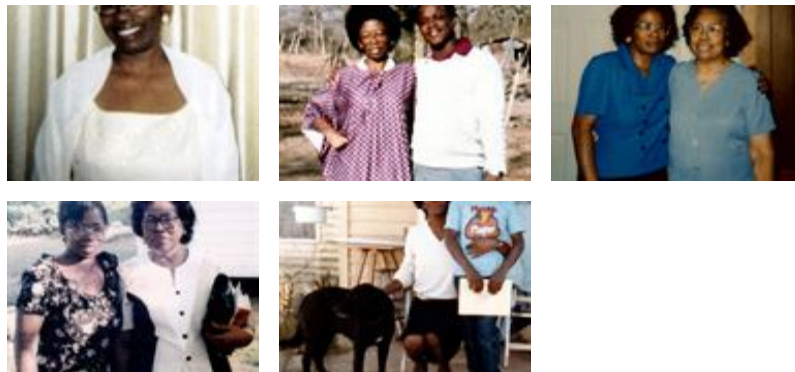

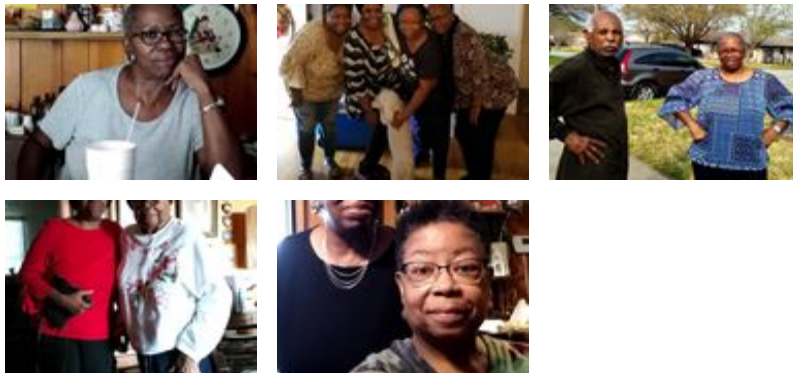
