Bill Morris, 88, of Bremond, passed away on Tuesday, May 26, 2015 at his residence. Graveside services will be at 11:00am, Thursday, May 28, 2015 at Lexington Memorial Cemetery with Pastor Lance Walsh officiating. Bill was born January 4, 1927 in String Prairie, Texas to John T. and U. B. (Rowland) Morris. He attended Lexington High School and Blinn College. Bill was a member of Lexington American Legion Post 6 for 67 years. He lived in Lexington most all of his life before moving to Bremond the past 3 ½ years. He married Bobbie Placke on June 14, 1952 in Lincoln, Texas. Bill was a crane operator for ALCOA for over 28 years before retiring. He was a U.S. Army veteran. 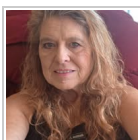

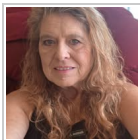
