



## Billie Ann Langehennig

January 10, 1935 - June 22, 2016

Funeral services for Billie Ann Langehennig, 81, of Lexington, Texas, are scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 25, 2016 at the Lexington United Methodist Church in Lexington with Rev. Wayne Calder officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Lexington Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, June 24, 2016 from 1:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, June 25, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. until 9:30 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Lexington. Billie Ann (Fricke) Langehennig was born on January 10, 1935 in Cameron, Texas, the daughter of William E. "Bill" Fricke and Pearl Pauline "Polly" (Locklin) Fricke. She was a lifelong citizen of Lexington, in Lee County, Texas, and attended Lexington ISD where she served as Drum Major and graduated with Valedictorian honors. She also spent summers in Fredericksburg, Texas spending time with her family that included her aunt, Annie Fricke, her uncle, Louis Rackel, her uncle, Herman "H.H." Fricke and his wife, Margaret and H.H. Fricke's son, Billy Fricke & his wife, Doris. 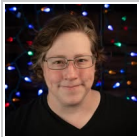
