Billy Eugene Hamilton, 73, of Iola, Texas went to be with our Lord and Savior on Thursday May 25, 2023. He departed peacefully in his sleep, surrounded by his loving family. A memorial will be held in his honor later this year at First Baptist Church of College Station.
