



Billy Graham Landrum

March 16, 1932 - February 27, 2016

Graveside funeral services for Billy G. Landrum will be held Wednesday, March 2, 2016 at 2 P.M. in the Taylor City Cemetery with military honors. Visitation will be Wednesday from 10:00 A.M. until noon at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale. Rev. Mel Swoyer of St. John's Lutheran Church in Thorndale will officiate at the graveside.

Billy was born on March 16, 1932 in Liberty Hill, Texas to the late W. C. Landrum and Willie Mae (Graham) Landrum. Billy lived in the Thorndale area most of his life. Billy attended business college in Austin after high school and later became an accountant with Alcoa Rockdale Operations from which he retired. He was a U. S. Army veteran and member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Thorndale and was a member of the Thorndale VFW. Billy loved gardening, baking, antiques, and especially spending time with his family.

Billy passed away Saturday, February 27, 2016 in the Scott and White Hospital in Round Rock, at the age of 83. He was preceded in death by his parents; son, Bradley Wayne Landrum on August 19, 1969; sister and brother in law, Eula Mae and Donald Purcell and niece Michelle Landrum.

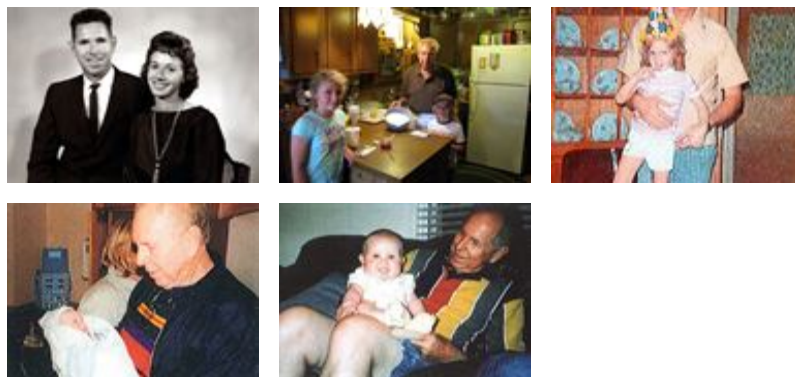
