Billy Ed Simank was called home to be with his heavenly Father on Thursday, February 6, 2020. A Memorial Service is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Thursday, February 13, 2020 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Thorndale with Pastor Aaron Kalbas officiating. 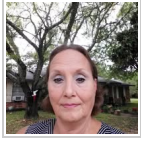
