



Binnie Louise "Peggy" Wilcox

April 23, 1939 - January 1, 2017

Binnie Peggy Louise Wilcox, 77, of Keene, Texas formerly of Caldwell, Texas, passed away, Sunday, January 1, 2017. Visitation will be Tuesday, January 3, 2016, from 5-7 pm at the Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell.

Services will be held at 11 am Wednesday, January 4, 2017 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home, with Rev. Steve Johnson officiating. Interment will be at Caldwell, Masonic Cemetery.

Born at Bobo's Clinic in Arlington, TX, April 23rd, 1939. She died on January 1st, 2017. Parents were Jack Russell Pruitt and Wave Virginia(Breon)Pruitt. She lived in the John T. White area of far East Ft. Worth where she attended John T. White Elementary school and Handley High School. She continued to live in that area for some 5 years after marrying Johnny Wilcox, who was a Burleson County native, before them moving to the Euless, TX area. She was a Baptist and belonged to the First Baptist Church of Euless before moving their membership to Caldwell First Baptist. She was a licensed Hair Dresser and worked for a short time in that area, but soon opted to be a 'stay -home' Mom to raise their children and attend to other family needs. Her many interests were reading, drawing, traveling and painting with both oils and water colour, but her greatest interest was gardening. She and Johnny were often visiting friends and relatives in Caldwell and she fell in love with the old Victorian homes spotted throughout the city, remarking that when they retired she would love to retire to one of those old homes. So, in July of 1989, she bought the old Taylor home at 606 W. Mustang and after some extensive work

and refurbishing the old home, they moved into and became permanent Caldwell residents where she often remarked that those years in that house was the happiest years of her life. Her back yard would be something that would really be admired by all that also had a 'green thumb. Blessed with so many joys of life, they were devastated in January of 2012, as she was diagnosed with FTD (Frontal Temporal Dementia). So, in August of 2013, they relocated to Chisolm Trail Retirement center in Keene, TX. The center had an Alzheimer Care Unit attached to the Apartment complex that would be perfect for them to deal with the disease. Late this year, December 2016, she also developed a Pulmonary Thrombosis condition that actually was what took her life. She was preceded in death by her parents, and infant brother, Bobby Jean Pruitt and brother-in-law Alfred L. Wilcox, Kent, Washington. Survivors are her husband of 61 years, Johnny L. Wilcox, daughter, Darra McWhorter, Burleson, TX., Sons Jonathan Wilcox, Moore, Ok., and Michael Wilcox and wife Cindy, Granbury, TX. grandsons Mark McWhorter, Nathan McWhorter, and Justin Norwood, USN. Granddaughters Jesse and husband Michael, Kara and husband Rob, and Kourtney and husband Shane. Peggy as most of her family and friends called her was a person that loved her husband and family with an unconditional love unmatched by any other mother and grandmother. She will be greatly missed by all.
