



Bobby Ray Rodgers

April 19, 1937 - March 1, 2015

Funeral services for Mr. Rodgers will be held Wednesday, March 4, 2015, 11:00 a.m. at the Tanglewood Baptist Church in Tanglewood, Texas. Burial will follow at the Hugh Wilson Cemetery in Tanglewood. Visitation will be at the Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Lexington on Tuesday, March 3, 2015 from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Sunrise for Bobby R. Rodgers came on April 19, 1937 in the community of Pleasant Grove in Lee County, Texas.

Sunset came on March 1, 2015, in Georgetown, Texas. He lived to be 77 years old.

Bobby was preceded in death by his father, Odie Connor Rodgers and mother, Bertha Mae (Bert) Rodgers and two children, Beverly Ann and Jeffery Lynn Rodgers.

Bobby is survived by sons, Ronald Wayne and Michael Ray Rodgers and their children and grandchildren.

Bobby moved to Houston where he met and married his wife, Jessie, in October 1959, and went to work for the City of Houston Fire Department. After 21 years of service he retired as a Captain. He and his family moved to Lexington to their farm. Bobby worked for the Lee County Sheriff's Department as a Deputy for 13 years while making many friends.

Bobby enjoyed working on his farm and traveling with his children and family. Bobby was active in the Masonic Lodge, American Legion and a member of the First Baptist Church of Lexington.
