



## Burton Frank "Burt" Graham

March 19, 1956 - August 27, 2021

Burton Frank Graham, 65, unexpectedly passed away after a short illness August 27th, 2021, in the Maury Regional Medical Center in Columbia, Tennessee. He was born fourth of five sons March 19th, 1956 in Cameron, Texas to Archie Newton Graham and Martha Belle Graham. He was a beloved son and brother. Burt graduated as valedictorian from Milano High School in 1974. He later received his Bachelor's degree in history from Baylor University and continued his education at Dallas Theological Seminary, graduating in 1983 with a Masters of Theology. Burt was easily recognized as a wonderful musician. He first began singing in church at a young age. His first song was “Christian Cowboy”, and his grandfather told him “Remember who you are singing for”. From singing on trail rides to performing with his brothers in their family band and eventually leading worship for many churches and gatherings; Burt's life was engulfed in music. He was also a gifted songwriter. Burt met the love of his life Terri, the woman he had been waiting many years for, in 1991 and July 11th, 1992, they were married. During their 29 years together the Lord's faithfulness was the overarching theme of their lived. God blessed them with three amazing children. Burt was passionate about the Word of God, sharing his love of pianos with others, good BBQ and honey. He was known and loved by so many for his humor, kindness, generosity,

compassion towards others and most notably his selflessness. Burt will be greatly missed.

He was preceded in death by brothers, Berry Archie Graham on May 23, 2005 and Robert Lafayette "Bob" Graham on May 14, 2012; nephews, Robert Reagan Graham on December 1, 1980 and Ben N. Graham on April 1, 1991; his father, Archie Newton Graham on May 13, 1998 and his mother, Martha Belle Graham on August 21st, 2017.

Surviving is his wife, Terri Hartmann Graham of Columbia, TN; daughter, Emma Belle Graham of Fishers, IN; two sons, Grayson James Graham of Waco, TX and Samuel Joseph Graham of Columbia, TN; brothers, William N. "Bill" Graham and wife Nan of Milano, TX and Benjamin D. "Ben" Graham of Milano, TX; sister-in-law, Renda Graham of Rockdale, TX; niece and nephew, Brooke Graham of Milano, TX and Boone Graham of Austin, TX.

Graveside services are scheduled for 1:30 p.m. Sunday, September 5th, 2021 in the Graham-Hurt Cemetery near Milano, Texas with Pastor Roy Dillard officiating. Burt's celebration of life will be held 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 8th, 2021 at the Bridge Christian Church, 380 Compton Road, Crawford, Texas 76638.

Burt and my husband Tommy were brothers in Christ and brothers of music. “Back in the day”, when Sherman Bible Church was still the “church in the trees”, Burt led worship with his mellow voice and gentle guitar paired with my Tommy on the piano. They were both such natural musicians that later when they formed a Christian band together with some talented friends, you would often hear them say “get in G and follow me.” No one who was there will ever forget Burt and Terri’s wedding. Best wedding ever! Thought I would actually die laughing when Elvis showed up to the party the night before. That night was the first time I got to hear Terri sing with her sister “How Beautiful”.
