Clyde Willis "C.W." Hales Jr. was born on February 16, 1942 in Cut and Shoot, Texas, the son of Clyde Willis Hales Sr. and Pauline Evelyn (Crawford) Hales. Mary Louise (Cannon) Hales was born on May 2, 1945 in Greenville, South Carolina, the daughter of Ernest Cannon and Ann Mae (Edwards) Cannon. C.W. and Mary were married on May 13, 1975 in Willis, Texas. Together they owned and operated CW Hales House Moving which C.W.'s father started in the 1960's. They moved the company to Giddings in 1984. In addition to leveling and moving buildings, C.W. and Mary were one of the original builders of "tiny houses" moving their projects all across the state of Texas. They worked side by side in every aspect of their business. When not working, they enjoyed taking vacation trips, especially to Las Vegas and spending time with their family. C.W. enjoyed working on his truck and Mary

spent many hours putting together puzzles.

C.W. and Mary passed away the same way in which they had lived, side by side and together, when a fire broke out in their home during the early morning hours of Monday, November 23, 2020 in Giddings.

C.W. was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Alice Faye Harris.

Mary was preceded in death by parents and a brother, B.J. Cannon.

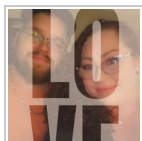
