



Carl Herman Biehle

Funeral services for Carl Biehle, 83 of Loebau, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 1, 2012 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas with Rev. Leif Hasskarl officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, July 31, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and Wednesday, August 1, 2012 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Tuesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Mr. Biehle passed away unexpectedly the afternoon of Tuesday, July 17, 2012 at University Medical Center Brackenridge in Austin from injuries he received in an automobile accident. Carl Herman Biehle, along with his twin brother, Ernest, was born on November 22, 1928 in Fedor, Texas to Reinhold & Alma (Dube) Biehle. Carl was baptized on November 23, 1928 and confirmed on April 18, 1943 both at Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor. His confirmation verse was John 13:35 " By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict and received his Honorable Discharge on November 26, 1952. Carl was united in marriage to Bernice Fritsche on April 19, 1953 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau, Texas. He was a carpenter who had worked at Koslan Brothers Furniture and Charles Arldt Construction. Carl was an active member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor where he had served in many offices and positions. He was a member of the Giddings American Legion Post 276 and enjoyed checking his cows, taking care of his garden, spending time outdoors and will be remembered

as always being a hard worker. He was preceded in death by his parents, Reinhold & Alma Biehle, step mother, Selma Biehle; sister and brother-in-law, Edna & Frank Haley; sister-in-law, Elizabeth Biehle and brother-in-law, Vestine Zoch. Carl is survived by his wife of 59 years, Bernice Biehle of Loebau; his daughter, Diane Biehle of Loebau; two brothers, Paul & Elaine Biehle of Paige and Ernest Biehle of Lexington; brother-in-law, Gene & Rose Fritsche of Loebau; sister-in-law, Irene Zoch of Houston as well as numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and many friends.
