



Carl Walter "C.W." Kasper Jr.

January 21, 1933 - June 18, 2020

Funeral services for C.W. Kasper Jr., 87, of Serbin, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 22, 2020 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday, June 21, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, June 22, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Kasper family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Carl Walter Kasper Jr. was born on January 21, 1933 in Winchester, Texas, the son of Carl Walter Kasper Sr. and Esther Louise (Krauskosky) Kasper. He was baptized on January 29, 1933 at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester by Rev. Erich Moebus and confirmed on March 30, 1947 also at St. Michael's Lutheran Church by Rev. Edward Rathgeber. His confirmation verse was Psalm 37:4, "Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart." C.W. graduated from La Grange High school in 1951, attended Blinn College where he played baseball and ran track, and graduated with an agricultural science degree from Sam Houston State University in 1959. He enlisted in the United States Army on March 8, 1954 and received his Honorable Discharge on February 28, 1962 having obtained the rank of Sp4. C.W. was united in marriage to Josephine "Josie" Theresa Kappler on June 6, 1959 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. He worked many years as a soil conservationist for the USDA-NRCS.

He also served as an insurance agent for AAL. C.W. was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, a former Post Commander for the VFW Post 4852 in Bonham and had also been an active member of the Bonham Moose Lodge. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, playing dominoes, and taking care of his cattle. C.W. loved everything baseball. He loved watching the St. Louis Cardinals, the Serbin Jack Rabbits, but most of all watching his grandchildren play even traveling long distances to catch their games.

C.W. passed away the evening of Thursday, June 18, 2020 at Ascension Providence Hospital in Waco.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; his son, Leslie Kasper; an infant brother, Leslie Kasper; two sisters-in-law, Ruth Lehmann & her husband, Roy and Happy Kappler, and two brothers-in-law, Rudie Lee Mitschke and James Tate.

C.W. is survived by his son, Carl W. "Butch" Kasper III of Serbin; his daughter and son-in-law, Teresa & Jacob Ray of Crawford; seven grandchildren, Tiffany Kasper-Riley of Windom, Brett Kasper of Victoria, Ty Kasper of Serbin, Brooks Kasper of Serbin, Kylie Ray, Jared Ray, and Megan Ray all of Crawford; two great grandchildren, Haylie Riley and Andrew Riley; one sister, Marilyn Pettepher & her husband, Don of Georgia; two sisters-in-law, Jeanette Mitschke of Winchester and Linda Tate of Serbin; one brother-in-law, Paul Kappler of Serbin, as well as several nieces and nephews.

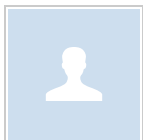

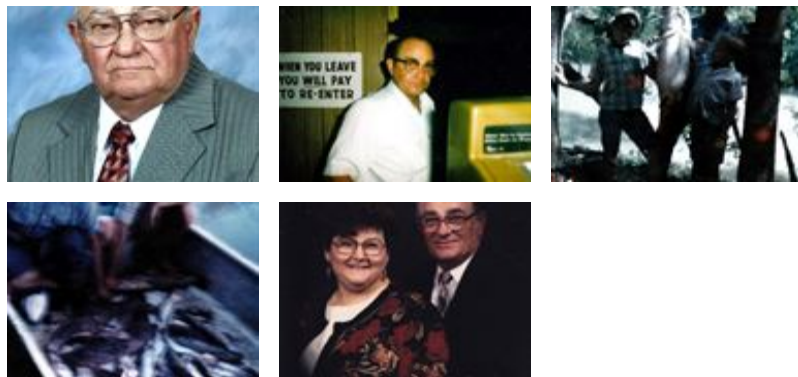
