Carol Ann (Kotrla) Eubanks, 69, of Caldwell passed away Monday, March 14, 2016 at Scott & White Memorial Hospital Temple. A memorial service will be held at 2 pm Sunday, March 20 at Harmony Baptist Church with Rev. Delmar McCracken officiating. The church will host a visitation and pot luck lunch at 12 Noon at the fellowship hall next to the church.
