Carol Green, 78, of Austin, formerly of Giddings, died peacefully in her sleep Tuesday, March 10, 2026. As dementia stole her from the present, it returned her to her happiest memories, reunited with her mother, brother, and father.

Services will be held at 12:00 pm, Monday, March 23, 2026, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Visitation will be held at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings on Sunday, March 22, 2026, from 9:00 am until 8:00 pm, and again on Monday from 7:00 am until 10:00 am; the family will be present from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm on Sunday.

Carol Ann was born September 2, 1947, in Brenham, Texas, to Elwood Domaschk Sr. and Lorine (Reuter) Domaschk. She was baptized on October 5, 1947 and confirmed on March 26, 1961 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Max Studtmann. Her confirmation verse was Romans 1:16 (For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.) After graduating high school, Carol went to college to earn her certificate in Secretarial Administration. She moved to Austin and went to work for the Department of Transportation as a clerk and retired as an Administrative Assistant.

Carol was a very kindhearted woman who always had a smile. Although she was a private person, she cultivated deep friendships that lasted for decades. She enjoyed traveling with her mother, testing her luck in Las Vegas, and joining her brother and family on trips as well. Carol and Lorine hosted many family gatherings and even more garage sales. She was a devoted daughter who was steadfast in the loving care she provided her mother during her cancer treatment. She saw many country & western acts, from local bars to ACL tapings in Austin, and enjoyed a polka, hiring Gil Baca for big celebrations. Carol loved her family, especially her godsons whom she enjoyed spoiling with elaborate Easter baskets filled with treats and toys. Over the years she also found joy and companionship in her dogs.

She is preceded in death by her parents Elwood Sr. and Lorine Domaschk; brother, Elwood Domaschk Jr., and many beloved aunts and uncles.

Carol is survived by her nephew Elwood "MJ" Domaschk III and wife Emily of Elgin; two nieces, Dawn Domaschk and husband Mattias Fischer of Berlin, Germany, and Lori Domaschk of Houston; two godchildren, John Domaschk and Elijah Domaschk of Elgin; sister in law, Jeannette Domaschk of Houston; as well as numerous beloved cousins, extended family, and dear friends.

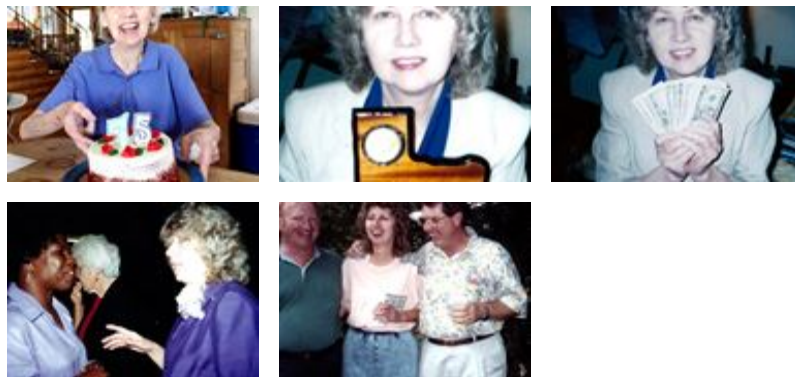
