



## Carol Jean Hohle

September 14, 1932 - September 2, 2015

Funeral services for Carol Hohle, 82 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 6, 2015 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, September 5, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Sunday, September 6, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Saturday evening from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Carol Jean (Luecke) Hohle was born on September 14, 1932 in Waldeck, Texas to Johnnie F. Luecke and Hermine E. "Minnie" (Walther) Luecke. She was baptized on October 2, 1932 at Waldeck Lutheran Church by Rev. Paul Eifert and confirmed on April 14, 1946 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Houston by Rev. Oliver Harms. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 37:4, "Delight thyself also in the Lord: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart." Carol was united in marriage to Raymond Leroy Hohle on November 4, 1950 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Houston by Rev. Oliver Harms. She worked as a bookkeeper at Trinity Lutheran Church in Klein for 17 years. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings where she was a member and served as an officer in the Ladies Aid. She was a member of the L.W.M.L., served as a church greeter and helped put together the Lutheran World Relief personal care kits. The project that was nearest and dearest to Carol's heart was the Lutheran World Relief Quilting Ministry. She spent

countless hours and produced numerous quilts for this ministry. She enjoyed sewing, quilting, handwork and embroidery. She and Leroy enjoyed traveling and had visited all 50 states and several countries. She was an avid reader and enjoyed playing 42 with her grandchildren. She valued the time she was able to spend with her family. Carol will be remembered for her ability to see only the good in those around her and was always willing to do anything for others.

Carol always said that she had her ticket to heaven and she was only waiting for her boarding pass. She finally received that boarding pass after battling cancer for 15 years and left this earthly world the evening of Wednesday, September 2, 2015, surrounded by her family, at her home in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Johnnie & Minnie Luecke; her daughter, Leigh Anne Hohle; her parents-in-law, John & Mathilda Hohle and her brother-in-law, Marvin Hohle.
