Funeral services for Nancy “Carole” Stewart, 73, of Midland, Texas and formerly of Giddings, Texas will be Thursday, November 5, 2020 at 10:00 am. Service will be held at St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings with Father Miguel Duarte officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, November 4, 2020 from 11:00 am until 8:00 pm, with a Rosary and Family in attendance starting at 7:00 pm. Viewing will continue on Thursday, November 5, 2020 from 7:00 am until 8:00 am at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings.

Our amazing beautiful mother, grandmother, friend, and sister, Carole, entered into the arms of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on October 28, 2020 at Manor Park in Midland, TX.

Nancy “Carole” Stewart was born on December 17, 1946 in Del Rio, Texas to Van Edward and Mary (Landrum) Tate. She was baptized at the First Presbyterian Church in Giddings in 1957. She received her sacraments of communion and confirmation in 1975 at Christ the King Catholic Church in Lubbock, Texas. Her last Rite of Anointing of the Sick was on October 27, 2020 with Father Timothy of St. Anne’s Church officiating. Carole attended St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings from 1984 until she moved to Fredericksburg in 2001 where she attended St. Mary’s Catholic Church.

Carole graduated from the Giddings High School in 1965 and was a very talented artist. She went on to attend Houston Baptist University for Art before deciding she could not live without the love of her life and sweetheart with whom she shared graham crackers with in Kindergarten, John “Jackie” Franklin Stewart III. She left art school to marry him on November 26, 1966 at St. Margaret in Giddings, Texas. She always wanted a large family and to be a mom. She had many talents and could do just about anything. She loved to sew, bake, and was an amazing cook; and man could she clean a house. She did everything with a full heart and detail and it showed. She loved to laugh and spend time with her “most prized possessions”, which were her children and grandchildren. She will always be remembered for her sense of style and humor.

Her work included volunteering at Lee Memorial Hospital in her teens, after her children were old enough she returned to Lee Memorial Hospital and was certified as a Respiratory Therapist. She then became a medical billing coder and manager for a durable medical equipment store in Giddings and in La Grange. During that time, Carole served as a Catechist at St. Margaret. After leaving her job at the medical equipment store, she became a medical billing coding specialist for Seton in Austin. She retired when she moved to Fredericksburg in 2001.

Carole is preceded in death by her parents, Van Tate and Mary Fields; husband, John Franklin Stewart III; son, John Franklin Stewart IV; sister, Diane Garner; parents-in-law, Dr. John Franklin Stewart II and Frances Bour Stewart; brother-in-law, Gregory Stewart and Buddy Schroeder, and sister-in-law, Rose Stewart.

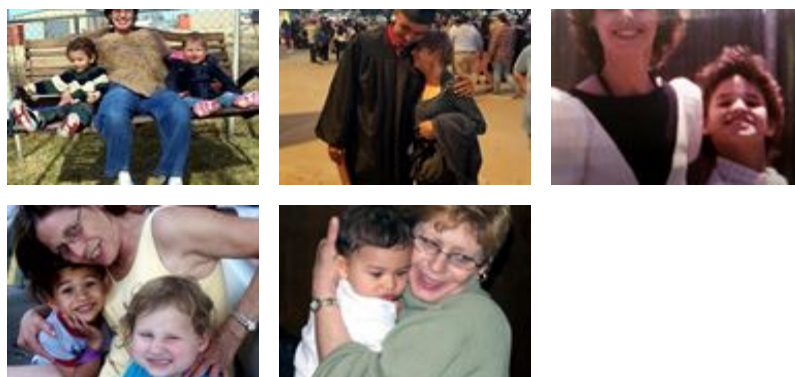

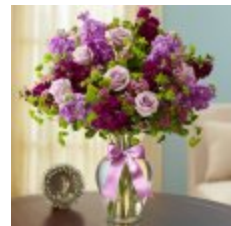
