



Caroline Matea Noack

Funeral services for Caroline Noack, 65 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. The services will be live streamed and can be viewed at stpaulserbin.org. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Noack family will be present Tuesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

Caroline Matea Noack was born on October 6, 1955 in Giddings, Texas to Juan & Rachel (Cantu) Gonzales. She was baptized on October 15, 1955 and confirmed on February 22, 1970 at St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings. Caroline passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, April 17, 2021 at her home in Giddings.

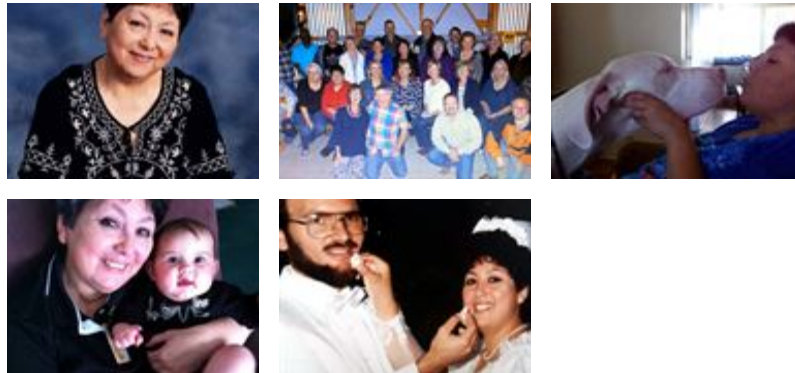
